<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Follow DRSABCD.</li> <li>2. Calm patient</li> <li>3. Flood stung area with vinegar for at least 30 seconds then pick off remaining tentacles</li> <li>4. If no vinegar available, remove tentacles using a stick or gloved fingers.</li> <li>5. Dial <b>000 in emergency</b></li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. To relieve pain; apply a cold compress or ice pack directly over the bite site</li> <li>2. Seek medical aid if necessary.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Follow DRSABCD.</li> <li>2. Calm patient.</li> <li>3. Place patient's stung limb in hot water (as hot as you can tolerate).</li> <li>4. Dial <b>000 in emergency</b></li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Follow DRSABCD.</li> <li>2. Calm patient and keep still.</li> <li>3. Apply PIB</li> <li>4. Dial <b>000 in emergency</b></li> </ol>
